About Locust Grove

Overlooking the Hudson River, the 180-acre Locust Grove Estate includes an Italianate villa designed in 1851 by architect Alexander Jackson Davis for artist and inventor Samuel F. B. Morse. The estate, with miles of carriage roads, landscaped grounds, historic gardens and Hudson River views, was preserved as a museum by the Young family, whose collection of art and antiques is exhibited in the mansion's 25 rooms.

In addition to public program offerings, enjoy the gardens and grounds, the self-guided carriage house tour, guided mansion tours and solo show exhibitions by noted regional artists.

Grounds are open to the public daily all year from 8 am to dusk, free of charge.

The Visitor Center and Museum Shop are open April – December, 10 am – 5 pm daily.

Guided mansion tours are offered daily May – November; weekends in April & December.
